2025 EACCR Measure Specifications

EACCR1: Early Tracheostomy Goals of Care Discussion

<u>Description:</u> Patients with > 96 hours of intubation and mechanical ventilation expected to require prolonged mechanical ventilation and/or their POA or families should engage in conversations clarifying goals of care prior to the 5th day of mechanical ventilation, to avoid late decisions regarding tracheostomy or comfort care.

<u>Denominator</u>: All patients >= 18 years of age on date of discharge intubated receiving mechanical ventilation >= 96 hours

<u>Numerator</u>: Patients/families who participated in a goals of care conversation that included discussions regarding prolonged mechanical ventilation, tracheostomy, and patient wishes / goals of care within one week (120 hours) of mechanical ventilation.

Denominator Exceptions:

- 1. Extubation or death expected within next 72 hours
- 2. No PoA/decision maker and patient unable to participate

Denominator Exclusions:

1. Pt expired

Firing Behavior:

Measure fires on critical care day 5, based upon 5 instances on unique days of 99291 or 94002. (Note: billing rules <u>do not allow</u> 99291 and 94002 to be billed on the same day by the same clinician/group, so this does not need to be accounted for in the specification). The ability to edit this response should remain active until hospital day 8, or discharge/sign off, whichever occurs first.

Prompts:

EACCR2: DEF Portion of [ABCDEF ICU Liberation Bundle] - Delirium Management; Early mobility; and Family Engagement in ICU patients

<u>Description</u>: Patients admitted to the intensive care unit (ICU) for > or = 3 days should be included in the 'DEF' portion of the ABCDEF bundle, including Delirium Assessment, Prevention, and Management; Early mobility; and Family Engagement and Empowerment

<u>Denominator</u>: All Patients >= 18 years of age on date of discharge with an ICU length of stay > or = 3 days.

<u>Numerator</u>: Patients receiving delirium screening, monitoring and management using the CAM-ICU method or Intensive Care Delirium Screening Checklist, and appropriate prevention and pharmacologic and non-pharmacologic management strategies as outlined in the ICU Liberation Bundle; AND participation in an early mobility program; AND Family engagement and empowerment including flexible visitation, daily meetings and participation in rounds, patient and family diaries and other resources to support family needs in accordance with the ICU Liberation Bundle.

<u>Denominator Exceptions</u>: Offered but patient/family declined; clinical contraindication, such as comfort measures or limited treatment, or mechanical circulatory support / extracorporeal membrane oxygenation *ECMO), or acute alcohol withdrawal.

Denominator Exclusions: Patients who expire.

Firing Behavior: Fires on 4th instance of 99291 (note: 2nd instance, for example, is a LOS of ~24 hours).

EACCR3: ABC Portion of [ABCDEF ICU Liberation Bundle] - Pain, Sedation, and Breathing management

<u>Description</u>: Patients admitted to the intensive care unit (ICU) for > or = 3 days that are intubated and have acute respiratory failure should be included in the 'ABC' of the ABCDEF bundle, including Assessment, Prevention and Management of Pain; Spontaneous Awakening/Breathing Trials, and Choice of Anesthesia and Sedation.

<u>Denominator</u>: All Patients >= 18 years of age on date of discharge (or sign off) receiving intubation and mechanical ventilation due to acute respiratory failure; AND ICU length of stay > or = 3 days.

<u>Numerator</u>: Patients whose Pain, Sedation, and Breathing (path to extubation) were managed in accordance with the ABC portions of the ICU Liberation Bundle, found here: https://www.sccm.org/iculiberation/abcdef-bundles <u>https://www.sccm.org/clinical-resources/iculiberation-home/abcdef-bundles</u>

<u>Denominator Exceptions</u>: Offered but patient/family declined; clinical contraindication, such as comfort measures or limited treatment, or mechanical circulatory support / extracorporeal membrane oxygenation *ECMO), or acute alcohol withdrawal.

Denominator Exclusions: Patients who expire.

Firing Behavior: Fires on next 99291 or 94002 on day after three 99291s or 94002. (i.e. ICU day 4)
