- At an academic, level 1 trauma center, we helped transition to performing all surgeries on bypass, we now extubate all patients within hours of surgery, and have brought down the observed-to-expected complication rate to 0.7.
- At another busy level 1 trauma center, we organized, developed, and implemented an overhead paging system to pull in extra hands for operating room emergencies.
- At another Sound partner hospital, we introduced electronic regional pumps with a patient-controlled bolus function. These saved the hospital \$40K per year, reduced the pharmacy's workload, and increased patient satisfaction.
